Set up email account (email address) and check often. (Advisors may request course syllabus, unofficial transcripts and/or course descriptions)

## Attend orientation

### Visit College Advisor to review:

- Become familiar with GOLD
- Unit requirements (average units per quarter)
- American History and Institution
- Residency requirements
- Grading options
- Change or add double major or minor
- Supplemental opportunities (EAP, UCDC, UCCS, research, etc.)
- Exceptions to policy
- Discuss General Education requirements

### Visit Major Advisor to review:

- Course planning/timeline
- Clear pre-requisites (may need course syllabus and/or unofficial transcripts)
- Pre-major requirements (if applicable)
- Declare major (if possible)
- Questions regarding exceptions/substitutions to major requirements
- Supplemental opportunities in department (honors, internships, research)
